A year ago, Scott and I were traveling east from California, our destination a new home and church we had never seen in person and a community we'd only begun to get to know. We were nervous but full of hope, certain God was calling us to Willow Creek.

And what a wonderful year it has been! You managed to welcome us well even during a pandemic, and you have graciously welcomed Emmett and supported us so kindly as we became a family of three (well, four, including our dog, Henry).

It's past time to make it official, y'all!

At long last, on October 17th, almost a year to the day from my first Sunday with you, we will celebrate together my Installation and Emmett's Baptism during our regular worship service. Our Book of Order says it like this: "In Baptism each Christian is called to ministry in Christ's name." In the liturgy for our Installation services, the first constitutional question begins like this: "In baptism, you were claimed by the love of God, clothed in the grace of Jesus Christ, and anointed with the gifts of the Holy Spirit to share Christ's mission in the world." I love this connection between Baptism and ministry. Our qualifications for ministry are the same as our qualifications for baptism - total dependence on the grace of God.

I can't wait to celebrate with you that amazing grace, as well as the clear sense of how at home my family and I feel here at Willow Creek.

I have invited a dear friend of mine to give the sermon and do the baptism. Rev. Joel Moore is the Senior Pastor of First Presbyterian Church of San Angelo (Texas). Many years ago, he was the Executive Director of the Atlanta Youth Project (an urban youth ministry non-profit) which I volunteered for when I was in college. This led to a friendship that has lasted nearly twenty years, as we ended up becoming neighbors, and then both eventually went to seminary and entered the ordination process, and were briefly on staff together at First Presbyterian Church of Atlanta. I am grateful that we will all have the opportunity to hear him preach on the 17th.

#### **Bank Draft**

A Bank Draft is an easy way to give monthly. Many of our members have chosen this method. Several advantages include: no church weekly giving envelopes, no need to write checks, no handling by the Church Financial Secretaries & there are no fees. Please contact our bookkeeper Diane Van Vleet at the church for assistance to set up a bank draft.

#### **Online Giving**

Through the website: willowcreekpc.org, click on the "Giving" or "Make a Donation" tabs and follow the instructions. This is a very simple method to give. There is a 2% fee per dollar amount on each transaction. On a gift of \$50 the fee would be \$1. If this is a recurring gift, and you would like to avoid the fees the church pays you may want to consider a bank draft.

#### **Church Envelopes**

This is a traditional method of giving. Church envelopes are generated for you and used to give weekly gifts. If you wish to receive or discontinue receiving a box of envelopes, please notify the church office.



## Stewardship Season: A Beacon of Light!

Willow Creek Presbyterian Church has long been a **beacon of light** in this community. As we reflect on our 176 years, and look toward the future, we are all invited to wonder how God is calling us to shine on - as individuals, and as a church. How is God moving us to give of our time, talent and resources this stewardship season? How can we share the good news of grace and how it is lived out at WCPC with just one more person?

Looking ahead to my second year here at Willow Creek (a year that I hope is less shaped by Covid) we have so much to be excited about. We will continue enjoying our old traditions while finding new ways to engage with our neighbors. I have already experienced your heart for this community, particularly through our Sleep in Heavenly Peace bed build and our Boone County Fair Respite Tent. We are planning more opportunities like this that will allow our neighbors to experience the beacon of light here on the corner of 173 and Belvidere.


We know we shine brighter when we combine our light with one another. All who give their financial offering to this church are incredibly generous, allowing us to continue to worship God and serve the community. Your giving goes to everything from mission funds - which support ministries around the globe - to staff salaries and the upkeep of our historic building. One of the ways we keep track of giving in the church office is by using "giving units", which are the number of individuals or households affiliated with the church. We currently have ninety-one giving units. Fifty-six percent of those ninety-one give using their designated envelopes or a check. (We know that other folks give as well, but choose not to use checks or the envelopes, which makes their gift anonymous.)

As Session has prayerfully planned for our Stewardship season, we wonder what it would be like if 100% of our giving units made a pledge this year. I ask you to prayerfully consider how God is moving you to give - of your time, talent and resources. And I ask that as an indicator of your prayerful consideration, you would pledge to give *something* for the upcoming budget year. It can be \$1 (or less!). The amount is not what matters. What matters is that we come together as individual lights to shine even brighter for God's glory. I would love to report that we have pledges from all of our giving units! What a message of unity and hope that would be as we all look toward the future with hope and faith.

Stewardship season will begin on Sunday, October 31st, and pledge Sunday is November 14th. More info on how to pledge will be coming soon. Your pledges are what we use to build the church budget. It is incredibly helpful to every aspect of our ministry to know what you hope to give throughout the year so that we can plan accordingly. I deeply appreciate each of you spending time in prayer as we continue in ministry together, shining bright as a beacon in our community.
