Dear Willow Creek Presbyterian Church Family,

It was a lot of fun planning Youth Sunday with the middle and high schoolers and their fearless leaders, Maren and Lucas. They helped write and approve the liturgy, and then we started talking about hymns.

It was a great opportunity to choose some favorites, including *Come, Thou Fount of Every Blessing*, which was the theme of the most recent Presbyterian Youth Triennium, which several of us attended. They also chose *Joy to the World*, because it fit with the proclamation in Psalm 67 that God's blessings will be known to the ends of the earth, *and* we talked about how even though we usually sing this hymn during Advent, it's not in that section in the hymnal. Advent hymns are #82 - #107, and the "Jesus Christ: Birth" or Christmas section is #108 - #156. *Joy to the World* is #266, way later, in the "Jesus Christ: Ascension and Reign" section.

Then we started talking about another favorite they were interested in singing, #697 *Take My Life*. This happens to be one of my all-time favorite hymns. As the youth group opened to that page in our planning meeting, someone (who shall remain nameless) said "We don't need to sing all of the verses, though!"

At first, I thought this was a joke. Then everyone else agreed! And I realized my opinion about singing all of the verses of hymns was the unpopular one.

I shared this story with the youth: My Great-Aunt was the music minister at her Baptist Church in Willard, NC. This was a small church that loved to do hymns sung during worship. Every now and then someone would dare to shout out "Hymn #8, but just the first two verses!". My Aunt Helena would fix her gaze on them and say: "The good Lord wrote four verses for this hymn, and *that* is how we'll sing it."

Now, beliefs around who wrote hymns and whether or not we should treat them as Scripture aside, apparently I have inherited a bit of that perspective. Sometimes, when I'm considering a particularly long hymn (like the six verses of *Take My Life*), I do wonder if we should just choose to sing some of it. But then when I start looking at the words that might be cut, I feel that it would be a loss. While I don't think "the good Lord" wrote these hymns, I do believe folks were moved by God's love to create beautiful music that helps us worship. I want to honor their hard work and intention, and I also always have such a hard time knowing *which* verses are cuttable! They all feel important to me - especially our hymns that are expressly Trinitarian. Many of the hymns in our hymnal have a verse dedicated to each Person of the Trinity, then one more verse pulling the ideas together and worshiping the Triune God - those are the hardest for me to cut from.

It was a very enlightening conversation with the youth and Maren and Lucas! I realized that I might be overthinking the hymns a bit, and that some folks might prefer a shorter version of some of our favorites. I will try to keep that in mind (and especially be mindful of our amazing musicians as they accompany our congregational singing!). But I wanted to share this with all of you and invite you to share your thoughts about the hymns with me: what are your favorites that you wish we would sing more often? Do you have an opinion about whether or not we should sing all of the verses? Are there hymns that aren't in our current hymnal (Glory to God) that you miss singing?

Keep me posted, and let's keep making a joyful noise unto the Lord!




Coffee & Fellowship




Worship in the Park


Sunday, **July 10**, 2022 @ 10:00 am, Aberdeen Park at 1343 Orth Rd, Belvidere, IL 61008
