As the leaves continue falling we turn our focus toward gratitude. We have much to be grateful for at Willow Creek. A growing church family – not simply more members, but we are growing together, being built together in Christ into a holy dwelling place of and for God.

Gratitude is like an inhale, and the exhale is giving. This church remains faithful and generous in every expression of giving - serving on committees, donating, financial pledges and contributions. Certainly I am very grateful for each of these, because without your faithful generosity, the beacon we offer to this community would dim.

Over the past year, the way we shine for the community has changed, and now a new season is upon us. We will begin our very first donation drive for our Mission Closet this month! (More information about our first Mission Closet project later in the Streamer).

Another new opportunity is on November 20th, the day of our Congregational Meeting and annual Hamball Dinner (recipe enclosed!). At the Hamball Dinner, we will have the chance to pack over 10,000 meals with Rise Against Hunger. We'll take turns meal-packing and enjoying our hamball potluck. It will take us about 2 hours to pack nutrient-rich, shelf-stable meals that will be sent around the world to folks suffering from famine, violent conflict, natural disasters, or other reasons that make food difficult to attain - a struggle we can hardly fathom.

This service project has opportunities for all ages and ability levels - we need folks who can simply sit and scoop rice into a bag, and we need folks who can quickly move around the room, refilling supplies.

This will be a different kind of fellowship for our hamball dinner - but as the Session considered all that we are grateful for, we wanted the opportunity to give as well. As we break bread (and hamballs!) at one of our favorite feasts of the year, we will also be able to serve and feed others.

I look forward to seeing you on November 20th!

On Sunday, Nov. 6th we will observe All Saints' Day, remembering the saints who are now in God's presence and honoring those whose memorial gifts have been used in the last year. It's not too late to return your pledge card! Pledge cards are available in the Fellowship Hall. Pledging helps us to know what you intend to give as we make our church budget, and the forms are an opportunity for you to tell us how you'd like to serve. We currently have 88 giving units (individuals or households who give), and so far 20% of those units have pledged - we would love to increase our percentage pledged! Per Capita Please submit your Per Capita prior to December 1, 2022 in order to meet the Blackhawk Presbytery Deadline.

Bank Draft A Bank Draft is an easy way to give monthly. Many of our members have chosen this method. Several advantages include: no church weekly giving envelopes, no need to write checks, no handling by the Church Financial Secretaries & there are no fees. Please contact our bookkeeper Diane Van Vleet at the church for assistance to set up a bank draft.

Online Giving Through the website: willowcreekpc.org, click on the "Giving" or "Make a Donation" tab and follow the instructions. This is a very simple method to give. There is a 2% fee per dollar amount on each transaction. On a gift of \$50 the fee would be \$1. If this is a recurring gift, and you would like to avoid the fees the church pays you may want to consider a bank draft.

Church Envelopes This is a traditional method of giving. Church envelopes are generated for you and used to give weekly gifts. If you wish to receive or discontinue receiving a box of envelopes, please notify the church office.



<u>Ham Balls Recipe - Recipe by Mrs. Carol Norem & from the 1956 Women's Auxiliary WCPC</u> <u>Cookbook</u>

/ lb ground lean smoked ham
/-//2 lb ground lean pork
2 cups bread crumbs
2 beaten eggs
/ cup milk

Make into balls, mix 1/2 cup water, 1 cup brown sugar, 1 teaspoon dry mustard and 1/2 cup vinegar to make sauce to pour over.

Place in a shallow pan and bake for 1 hour or more. Baste occasionally.


