You never know who is going to come through our church doors.

A few weeks ago, a car pulled up and a gentleman we didn't recognize got out and came to the door holding an envelope. Shannon greeted him, and he launched into this story:

"I grew up nearby, and one summer morning, a friend and I rode our bikes over, and were just fooling around, being kids. Just for fun, we decided to check the doors, and as luck would have it, they were unlocked. It felt like an adventure to just come in and have a look around. No one was here and we had a great time exploring, half scared to death thinking we would get caught. Well, we found some stamps and quarters by the office. We took them. I don't know why, it was just something dumb for a couple of bored kids to do. Felt thrilling then, but it's bothered me all these years. Anyway, I was just back in the area, and I've been wanting to make this right, so, here."

He handed her the envelope, which was full of stamps and quarters. She thanked him and he left.

I love that one long-ago summer day our church was open for a couple of kids to find an adventure. I love that they had the chance to make a mistake here – a small one, I doubt that anyone ever noticed those stamps and quarters were gone, and even if the loss was noticed, it would have been quickly, easily replaced. I wouldn't have wanted this man to be burdened with guilt over his childish impulsive choice all of these years, and still, I love that he felt the freedom to return here and make things right.

This encounter reminds me once again that this building represents something to people – to each of us, yes, and also to folks we may never meet. So many people use our church as a landmark – it represents a memory or marks the distance on a drive. Perhaps it reminds them of another church, somewhere. It evokes some notion of sacredness and divinity.

This church is, of course, so much more than the physical building, and yet – I wonder what we can learn about our identity as Christ's church from the way people encounter these old brick walls. My hope is they sense some of God's holiness in the way we live our lives, and that they feel comforted by the way we offer grace – in the same way holiness is felt in the shadow of the soaring steeples and comfort is found in the quiet grace of our sanctuary.




The meeting closed in prayer at 7:30 pm

There are Angels God puts on this Earth. Who care for us and guide us. You can feel their love and gentleness as they walk through life beside us.


They do great things for us every day They whisper in our ears, They even hold us in their hearts When we are filled with all our fears.
