SERMON SERIES: THE CONFESSIONS The PCUSA has a constitution made up of two parts: the Book of Order and the Book of Confessions. The Book of Order is our polity - the rules we follow to make sure we do things decently and in order, and also with a whole lot of grace. The Book of Confessions is the eleven statements that our denomination has affirmed which guide our understanding of our history while also shaping our present practice of faith. Each confession was written to articulate what it means to follow Christ here and now. We will learn about the context - the "here and now" - of a different confession each week, and learn how our ancestors in the faith interpreted Scripture as they sought to understand what faithfulness looked like in their particular time and place. We will begin with learning about the Scots Confession on Kirkin' Sunday, and end our series on October 29th, Reformation Sunday. I look forward to digging into our Reformed roots with you!
