<u>A NOTE FROM PASTOR LAUREN</u> There is an old Lenten tradition of "burying the hallelujah". Hallelujah (or alleluia) is a proclamation or praise that *Christ* is *Risen*! We save this shout for Easter morning, and through the season of Lent, we commit to not say or sing *hallelujah* - but instead to focus on *hosanna*, the cry before *hallelujah*, the cry of: God save me!

I try to honor this practice. It's like observing Holy Saturday during Holy Week. On that somber day, we are invited to sit with the reality of Christ's death. We contemplate our God's experience of death – as the One who died on the cross, and also as the Ones who grieved because the Beloved was crucified. However, if ever there was a place where rules and traditions must give, it is in the presence of grief. After all, grief does not follow any rules. So I break the tradition of "burying the hallelujah" at the graveside, where our liturgy includes these words: "Yet even at the grave we make our song: *alleluia*, *alleluia*, *alleluia*." I also break this rule when I announce a death in church and recite a verse from the hymn For All the Saints: "O blest communion, fellowship divine, we feebly struggle, while they in glory shine, yet all are one in Thee, for all are Thine, *Alleluia*, *Alleluia*."

Each death is an Easter celebration - all of the grief, as well as all of the hope in Resurrection. Death still stings. We still grieve. And yet, we have hope in a God who knows the sting of death, and has undone it. With gratitude for this hope, we continue our Lenten journey to the cross.

<u>CHANGE FOR CHANGE</u> Every **second** Sunday, we invite you to participate in this special offering. When we all put our left over dollars and loose change together, the amount really adds up! Change for Change goes to our Family In Need Fund, which helps folks in our church family and wider community in need of assistance.

<u>CONFIRMATION SUNDAY</u> Congratulations to our confirmands Argyle Greenlee, Will Monroe and Charlie Shipton! They completed all of the requirements of the confirmation class which met from November 2023 until February of 2024. It was a joyous day at Willow Creek when we celebrated the Sacrament of Baptism with Will, and welcomed Argyle, Will and Charlie as new members.
