

A NOTE FROM PASTOR LAUREN There is a notecard on my desk with this quote attributed to Martin Luther: "Even if I knew that tomorrow the world would go to pieces, I would still plant my apple tree." There is some debate over whether or not Martin Luther said this. It's a fair question, as his writing tended to be far less practical than this particular wisdom: no matter how bleak things look, it's always a good time to plant a seed that might grow into a provider of shade and sustenance for generations to come. Planting is always an act of faith - whether you're gardening casually, farming seriously, or planting the metaphorical seeds of care and concern for others. Planting is always an act of faith, and always a good reminder of what it means to have an active faith. Active faith is work - we prepare the soil, plant the seeds, and water and weed, always in prayer. God is the one who causes seeds to break open while still covered in soil, and new growth to push through to the surface. Planting is an act of faith that reminds us that even the question of how much new growth depends on our activity and how much depends on God is a holy mystery that has no clear answer, but does end in an invitation from God for us to participate. What seed is God planting in your life that leads you to participate in this community of faith? What gift are you being called to share with others that could yield fruit beyond your imagination?
