As a pastor, Bullinger was known for welcoming religious refugees into his own home and attending to victims of Zurich's 1564 Plague even at the risk of infection and death. Bullinger originally intended the confession to be attached to his last will and testament, but political events led him to share it with others, and it soon became adopted by the churches of Switzerland.

The language of the confession has been slightly modified for our usage.
