

Liturgist: Ron Muzzarelli Ushers: Mike Landi, Steve Picken, Shannon Reagan and Ed Rottman Every Sunday, we join our voices together to **affirm what we believe** using the Book of Confessions. Yale History Professor Jaroslav Pelikan once said this: My faith life, like that of everyone else, fluctuates. There are ups and downs and hot spots and cold spots and boredom and ennui and all the rest. And so I'm not asked on a Sunday morning: 'What do you believe?' I'm not asked to sit down and write what I happen to believe today. Instead, with a common confession, we answer the question "What do you believe?" as a member of a community which for a millennium and a half has said: We believe in One God. Rather than figuring it out as individuals, we turn to faithful followers of Christ throughout time and around the world to see how they answered: What do you believe? Today's confession is from **A Brief Statement of Faith**, which was written when the two largest Presbyterian churches in the United States reunited in 1983 after splitting over the practice of slavery prior to the Civil War. This expressly Trinitarian confession calls the church's attention to God's eternal sovereignty and reminds us that the church is not only a refuge from the world, but rather the church is always being reformed into the body by which Christ continues blessing all of creation and all of God's children.
