Every Sunday, we join our voices together to affirm what we believe using our denomination's Book of Confessions or words from Scripture. Scholar Jaroslav Pelikan once said: My faith life, like that of everyone else, fluctuates. There are ups and downs and hot spots and cold spots and boredom and ennui and all the rest...And so I'm not asked on a Sunday morning: 'What do you believe?' I'm not asked to sit down with a three-by-five index and write down what I happen to believe today. Instead, with a common confession, we answer the question "What do you believe" as a member of a community which now for a millennium and a half has said: We believe in One God. On Communion Sundays, this church typically confesses using the Nicene Creed. This is our most ecumenical creed. More Christians throughout time and around the world have confessed their faith using these words than any other confession or creed.


