A NOTE FROM PASTOR LAUREN During Lent, we commit to contemplating our own mortality. We begin the season with the imposition of ashes and the refrain: remember you are dust, and to dust you shall return. We make our way through the season singing Hosanna - Lord, Save me! And we end proclaiming Alleluia! on Easter as we celebrate the Resurrection of our Lord.

Which of these places would we choose, if the choice was ours? To spend our days contemplating mortality, or shouting "Hosanna!" or singing "Alleluia!"?

Most of us would choose to hang out on Easter Sunday. We love those *Alleluia!* days when the spring sunshine is just warm enough, the scent of new blossoms are brought to us on a gentle breeze, and we're surrounded by laughter and love.

But of course, we don't get to choose. As much as we love those sweet *Alleluia!* days, the life God has written for us weaves from *Alleluia!* to *Hosanna!* to the days of contemplation in-between. And the faith we have been given by the grace of God equips us for each of those days. The particular gift of Lent is to walk through ordinary days with a deepening awareness of our finite nature: we have a limited amount of time and energy and even faith. That is how we are created. God - the Infinite One - does not expect us to be any more than what we are. So for Lent, we practice growing in awareness of and loving our limitations.

This Lent, you are invited to explore our limitations by reading **Being Mortal** by Atul Gawande for our **Lenten Soup Study**. We will meet Wednesdays during Lent from March 12th through April 9th 5:30p - 7p. You may want to read along with us even if you can't join us for soup! And all are welcome - join us for discussions even if you aren't reading the book.
